WEDNESDAYS from 11AM - 6PM


THURSDAYS from 10AM – 5PM

## **How do I make a request for Pickup?**

- Go to our online catalog (<a href="https://iiisy1.einetwork.net/search">https://iiisy1.einetwork.net/search</a>) and use the drop down box below "Look in the Following Location" to select **South Park Twp.** This will limit your search results to items we own and will tell you if they are available or not.
- Please call ahead to request items before arriving for pickup at 412-833-5585. We cannot add holds to your account for items not at South Park Township Library.
- When you are headed to the library or arrive at the Library for pickup,
   please call us at 412-833-5585. Library staff will check out items to your
   account and place them in the vestibule in a bag labeled with your name.
- The pickup is non-contact, but masks are still encouraged. Please only
  enter our vestibule, one person at a time for social distancing purposes.
- The Library IS CLOSED to the public beyond the vestibule.
