### Our Fellow Township Residents:

The Coronavirus is the main focus of everyone at this time. Many facilities and businesses are responding to health agency mandates by closing. Please be advised that, as an essential service, South Park Township's administrative offices will remain open to the public during normal operating hours, being Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Public Works and Police Departments are fully staffed and will continue to provide public safety, as well as address Township maintenance activities. However, Township officials have instituted the following measures in accordance with recommendations received from the Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC):

- ❖ South Park Township Library is closed to the public through March 29<sup>th</sup>. The situation will be evaluated at that time to determine if further closure is warranted. Library staff will be answering the phone Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- ❖ The Community Center is closed to all groups and organizations through March 29<sup>th</sup>. Again, the situation will be evaluated to determine if further closure is warranted.
- ❖ The Brunch with the Bunnies event scheduled at the Community Center on April 4, 2020, is cancelled.
- ❖ All fitness classes have been suspended until further notice. Classes will resume once normal Library operating hours are restored.
- ❖ Please do not contact South Park Township for information related to the Coronavirus, other than the status of Township operations. We are not a medical facility and cannot dispense medical advice.
